**Race.** In June 08 we had a fine single kayak 3 mile race starting at our \$1,000,000 new 220 ft wide beach located at the tip of Anchor Bay nestled at the foot of our cozy New Baltimore Downtown. Everyone enjoyed the 3 mile course as did our spectators who saw it all from our brand new PIER located at the near center of the three lap course. At the start the kayaks were lined up on the edge of the beach with the racers inland 15 yards. The race started with the paddlers proceeding unassisted to their kayaks. Everything about the June race was just great so we are going to do it again in exactly the same way.

**Lunch & Post Race Party.** One block from the beach Stahl’s Bakery complete with outside tables served great deli foods and where we presented the awards and commemorative gifts. This was equally enjoyable for all so we are going to do this again along with a lunch of a Stahl’s sandwich, cola, famous Belly Button cookies, and ice cream all included in the event package entry fee.

**Kayaking Tour.** At 2:00 PM we are going to return to our Kayaks waiting for us at our great beach, and embark on a casual 3 hour tour of upper Anchor Bay guided by Jeanne Bocci at her best [and, of course, most fun loving persona]. The tour will be accompanied by a safety craft and a captain who knows how to open a refreshing can of our favorite soft drinks. When we all return at about 5:00 PM our beach is open for swimming and our waterfront park available for your own picnicking pleasures.

The race, lunch, awards, commemorative gifts, and kayaking tour are all included in a \$25 Pkg Pre Entry Fee and \$30 Race Day Entry Fee. You must wear a life vest and sign a Release of Waiver on race day. Please make checks payable to City New Baltimore DDA and mail with Entry Form to Event Chair Max Plante, DDA Sec, as listed above.

**Directions to New Baltimore.** Go East on I-94 towards Port Huron. Avoid construction - turn right at only Exit 247 Washington Street and go a straight shot 2.7 miles through Downtown to the Beach. You can’t miss Anchor Bay!
