

Interested in participating in the 1st Annual ABCC “Christmas Around the World” Sleigh Race

An ABCC Sleigh is a very exquisite Aircraft and must be:

1. Named
2. Decorated to represent your business or organization tying in with the holiday theme.
3. Displayed for the public to admire them and visit to take selfie's promoting your business and your Sleigh
4. Properly turned to compete in the Christmas Around the World Sleigh Race Night

Naming Your Sleigh: Of course, every “Sleigh” needs a name. This year we are asking Sleigh Owners to dress their Sleigh in a **Christmas** theme and name it accordingly.

Sleigh Name / Theme Selection: It is important that you register your ABCC Sleigh name as soon as possible. Please contact: Santa’s Helper, Catherine Green at Anchorbaychamber@yahoo.com or phone 586-725-5148.

Name Deadline: You MUST REGISTER it no later than December 8th (Earlier if possible!!!) Information is also required for a variety of marketing material, prepared prior to the event.

Publicly Display Your Sleigh: Be a proud Sleigh Owner; display your sleigh at your business or any location you can! Take a selfie with your Racing Sleigh and take advantage of this marketing opportunity for your business! Email your selfie and they will be posted on the chambers web page until the end of the race.

Decorating Your Sleigh: Your sleigh needs to be appropriately decorated to compete for the Most Beautiful Sleigh Contest and the Most Popular Sleigh Contest (Most Money Raised), which will be determined on the evening of the Christmas Around the World Race.

Guideline: Your Sleigh is representing you and your business; please keep it professional and suitable for “Baby Elves Eyes” Be creative – competition is fierce!

SLEIGH RACE RULES

- A. There will be 18 Sleighs racing with 3 Heat Races. Six ABCC Sleigh are aligned at position one (1) on the designated Track and each shall be prominently numbered from one (1) to six (6).
- B. A numbered cube shall be thrown, and ABCC Sleigh with the corresponding numbers shown on the numbered cube shall be moved one (1) position forward.
- C. This process will continue until one of the ABCC Sleigh reaches the position ten (10) on the track and is declared the winner. There for there is no way for any racer to tie.
- D. Winning ABCC Sleigh move on to the next heat.
- E. Losers are eliminated from the competition.
- F. The three winners will race against each other in a fourth race using the number cube. Sleigh 1, will move one space when number cube lands on 1 and 4,
Sleigh 2, will move one space when number cube lands on 2 and 5
Sleigh 3, will move one space when number cube lands on 3 and 6.
The first two winners will go on to race in the last heat race.
- G. The last heat will be with the last two remaining ABCC Sleigh from the elimination rounds. In this Race, the ABCC Sleigh will be assigned “Even” or “Odd” number.
Sleigh 1, will move one space when number cube lands on a “Even Number”
Sleigh 2, will move one space when number cube lands on a “Odd Number”
The first one to the Finish line will be the Champion
- H. This process will continue until one of the ABCC Sleigh reaches the position ten (10) on the track and is declared the winner.

RAFFLE

- A. There will be a total of 80 tickets maximum sold per race at \$5 each for a total of \$400
- B. Guest will use their ticket to bet on just one ABCC Sleigh.
- C. Half the funds collected per race will be divided to all the guest who bet on the Winner. Half will go to the Anchor Bay Chamber of Commerce

Example: If ABCC Sleigh (A) wins and 10 tickets have been sold, the \$200 winners pot is divided by 10 and each winner receives \$20
